GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED

The "Sustainable Fish Value Chains for Small Island Developing States (SVC4SIDS), (GCP/GLO/098/ROK)" implemented by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), with funding from the Ministry of Oceans and Fisheries of the Republic of Korea, is working closely with the Kiribati Ministry of Fisheries and Marine Resource Development (MFMRD) and other national partners to play a significant role in boosting tuna value chains towards ensuring food security and reducing poverty. The project aims to provide support to existing initiatives led by Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in micro-processing and value addition.

In this regard, the project will need the services of Building construction Supervisor- for Makin that will closely supervise the delivery of activities in the project sites in Kiribati. The building construction Supervisor- for Makin will work under the overall supervision of the Sub-Regional Coordinator for the Pacific with direct supervision from the SAP Fisheries and Aquaculture Officer, technical guidance from the HQ Project Coordinator, and working in close coordination with the National Project Manager and Senior Fish Value Chain Expert in Kiribati.

The Building Construction Supervisor- for Makin shall carry out the following duties:

1. Support project management team to ensure quality and professional work is being undertaken with the construction of the new Makin Island fish Center;
2. Hands on supervision and assistance with daily construction work on the Makin island fish center;
3. Ensure all construction meets the designs developed by MISE;
4. Provide technical support for local contractor to understand the design drawings and to ensure full compliance with all structural details;
5. Join weekly virtual meetings with project management team;
6. Liase with Island council to ensure smooth facilitation of works on the island; and
7. Perform other duties as required.
